

Health Info in Classroom (Gradebook)

Teachers can view Health information on students in Classroom. Details such as Health Conditions, Emergency Plans, Vision Screenings, and Hearing Screenings are contained on the Health Information screen.

Viewing Health Information on a Single Student

In Classroom, open a class roster of students.

1. Highlight a student on the roster screen.
2. Click the **iGear** icon.
3. Click **Student**.
4. Click **Health Information**.

In Classroom, open a class roster of students.

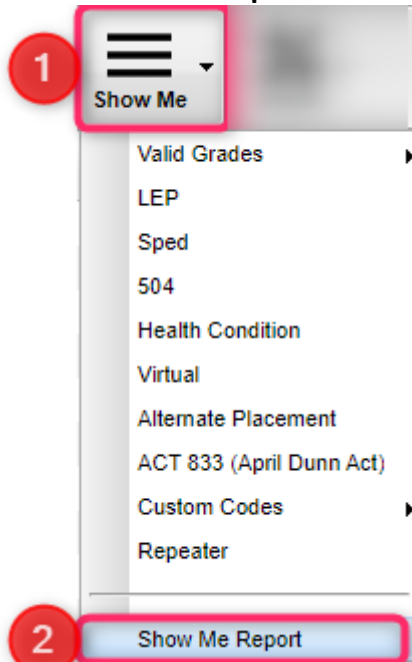
1. Click the **Show Me** icon.
